DID YOU KNOW ?

City Ordinances requires all dogs living within the city limits to be registered with the city

Steps on how to register:

1. Get your dog current on the Rabies vaccine, with your vet!
2. Call Animal Control at 432-445-4911 and schedule a time to come in!
3. Bring your pets current rabies vaccination record and \$15 (cash, check, or money order, payable to TOPC) to your appointment!
