Postponing the Special Election to fill Council Seat #5 due to COVID19 Concerns

A RESOLUTION POSTPONING THE SPECIAL ELECTION OF MAY 2020 TO FILL COUNCIL SEAT #5, UNTIL NOVEMBER 2020 DUE TO HEALTH AND SAFETY CONCERNS AS A RESULT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, The Town of Pecos City is a Home-Rule City duly incorporated under the Laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, The recent COVID-19 pandemic has raised health and safety concerns for our citizens and voters; and

WHEREAS, Many of our voters could be considered to be in the high-risk categories of exposure to the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, The City desires to implement the recommendations of the Center for Disease Control (CDC) with regards to minimizing the effects of the COVID-19 virus by eliminating large gatherings, practicing "social distancing", and protecting those who are considered to be high-risk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PECOS CITY, TEXAS:


Section 1. That the findings set out in the preamble to this resolution are hereby in all things approved and adopted.

Section 2. That the special election to fill Seat #5 of the City Council, originally scheduled to be held on May 2, 2020 is hereby postponed until the November 3, 2020 National Election.


Section 3. That the City Manager or their designee is hereby authorized to execute all documents related to these actions on behalf of the Town of Pecos City.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective from and after its passage.
