

RESOLUTION NO. 25-08-03R
Call for Elections November 4, 2025

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PECOS CITY, TEXAS CALLING FOR A GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE REAUTHORIZATION OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX AT THE RATE OF THREE- EIGHTHS OF ONE PERCENT TO CONTINUE PROVIDING REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS; CONSIDER AMENDING ARTICLE II, SECTION 2.09, "COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL", OF THE TOWN OF PECOS CITY CHARTER

WHEREAS, the Town of Pecos City is a home rule city acting under its charter to ensure continuity of government; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.004(b) of the Texas Election Code provides that the governing body of a municipality shall be the authority to order An Election for the purposes of voting "For" or "Against" a measure; and

WHEREAS, Section 41.001(a) of the Texas Election Code calls for a General Election to be held on November 4, 2025, being the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, at which time the voters will vote "For" or "Against" the Reauthorization of the Local Sales and Use Tax at the rate of three-eighths of one percent to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets in the Town of Pecos City; and

WHEREAS, the currently authorized Street Maintenance Tax is set to expire approximately four years after its reauthorization passage and this Tax must be reauthorized by the Citizens of Pecos; and

WHEREAS, the voters will vote "For" or "Against" an amendment to Article II, Section 2.09, "Compensation of members of the council," of the Town of Pecos City Charter; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.004(a) of the Texas Election Code provides that the governing body of a municipality on its own motion may submit a proposed charter amendment to the municipality's qualified voters for their approval at an election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PECOS CITY:

Section 1. General Election Called. An election is hereby ordered to be held on November 4, 2025 between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM to consider:

Proposition 1:

The reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the Town of Pecos City at the rate of three-eighths of one percent to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of

municipal streets. The Tax expires on the fourth anniversary of the date of this election unless the imposition of the tax is reauthorized.

Proposition 2:

Shall Article II, Section 2.09, "Compensation of members of the council," of the Town of Pecos City Charter be amended to read as follows?:

"Each member of the council shall receive for their services such compensation as is provided by law, or as may hereafter be set by the council by ordinance. Such compensation shall be at the sum of twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000.00) per annum per councilmember and the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) per annum for the mayor, together with health insurance benefits. In addition to the above, all necessary expenses incurred by the mayor or other members of the council in the performance of their official duties shall be paid by the city. Such compensation shall be subject to annual appropriation by the City's budget."

Además de lo anterior, todos los gastos necesarios incurridos por el alcalde u otros miembros del concejo en el desempeño de sus funciones oficiales serán pagados por la ciudad. Dicha compensación estará sujeta a la apropiación anual en el presupuesto de la ciudad.")

Section 2. Conduct of Election. The election shall be conducted according to the Texas Election Code, Texas Constitution and the Town of Pecos City, Texas City Charter.

Section 3. Joint Election Agreements Approved. The Mayor is authorized to enter into joint election agreements and contracts for election services as may be necessary for conducting this election.

Section 4. Dates and Locations. The Town of Pecos City plans to hold a General Election, on November 4, 2025, with early voting occurring from October 20, 2025 until October 31, 2025. The Town of Pecos City will share a common early voting polling location, if need be, for the November 4, 2025, General Election at the Reeves County Civic Center, 1520 S. Cedar St. Pecos,

Texas and election day voting occurring where Reeves County designates voting will take place.

Section 5. Notice of Election. Notice of election shall be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation beginning on the 30th day before the election and no later than the 10th day of the election as required by the Texas Election Code. The notice of election will be posted on the front door/window of City Hall, two places within the City and on the City website.

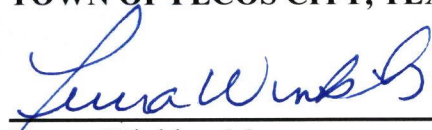
Section 5. Authorization Granted. The City Manager and City Secretary, in consultation with the City Attorney, are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to comply with the provisions of Federal and State law in carrying out and conducting the election, whether or not expressly authorized herein.

SEVERABILITY: If any article, section, subsection, clause, paragraph, sentence or phrase of this resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalid article, section, subsection, clause, paragraph, sentence or phrase is hereby declared to be severable; and any such invalid or unconstitutional article, section, subsection, clause, paragraph, sentence or phrase shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution; and it is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council to enact each section and portion thereof individually, and each such section shall stand individually if necessary, and be in force regardless of the determined invalidity or unconstitutionality of any article, section, subsection, clause, paragraph, sentence or phrase thereof.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.

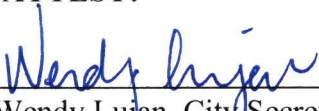
