- Drilling Permit Application
- Surface Use Plat (Site Plan)
- Truck Route Plan to access property

Once the drilling permit is approved it will not be issued until the City Secretary office has received:

- Copy of Insurance
- Copy of Bond
- FAA Clearance (if required)
- \$500 permit fee

CHAPTER 44 – OIL AND GAS WELLS NOTES

Section 44-8 Derrick & Rig – Fence will be installed upon completion of well.

Section 44-12 Mufflers Requires – Diesel generators will be utilized

Section 44-13 Storage tanks & Separators – Above ground separators will be utilized.

Section 44-14 Fence – A Hurricane Chain Link Fence with Slates will be utilized

Section 44-17 (b) Fire Prevention – Fire Extinguishers will be on location. Drilling contracts follow API standards.

Section 44-48 Insurance and Bond – must file a bond no to be less than \$25,000.00 and carry a policy or policies of standard comprehensive public liability insurance, including contractual liability covering bodily injuries and property damage, naming the permittee and the city in an insurance company authorized to do business with the state. The policy or policies in the aggregate shall provide for the following minimum coverages:

- a) Bodily injuries \$100,000.00, one person; \$300,000.00, one accident;
- b) Property damage \$200,000.00

If, after completion of a well, the permittee has complied with all of the provisions of the chapter, such as to removing derrick, clearing premises, etc., he may apply to the city council to have the insurance policies reduced as follows:

- a) Bodily injuries \$50,000.00, one person; \$100,000.00, one accident;
- b) Property damage \$50,000.00;

for the remainder of the time the well produces without reworking. During reworking operations, the amount of the insurance policy or policies shall be increased to the original amount.
