



Restaurant Dining-In Opening Guidelines

Beginning May 1, 2020

As per the Governor Abbott's Executive Order that was issued on April 27, 2020, a limited opening of businesses may occur including restaurants, retail stores, malls, libraries, museums and movie theatres. Town of Pecos City will adhere to the guidelines in the protocols outlined in the document "Open Texas" that can be found on the Governor's website gov.texas.gov/opentexas pages 27-29. Pecos will be recognizing the 25% total building occupancy calculation at this time until further notice. The following are guidelines in order to reopen to stay in compliance with the protocols set forth by the Governor's Office. They are as follows:

- Parties/groups need to maintain the social distancing requirements of the 6 feet distancing from other parties/groups at all times which includes while waiting to be seated.
- A hand sanitizing station must be available upon entering the restaurant.
- Tables must be occupied by no more than 6 people.
- Condiments, silverware, flatware, glassware or other traditional items are not to be left on an unoccupied table.
- Condiments are to be provided upon request in only single use portions.
- Disposable menus are to be provided for each patron.
- Restaurant employees must serve customers at establishments with buffets.
- **Restaurants that are required to post a 51% sign per their alcohol license from the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission are NOT allowed to operate their dining rooms at this phase of openings.**
