
Arthur Orona, Councilmember, thanked the frontline employees working through this pandemic, with a apraxia shout out to line men that work for the electrical company.

B. Non-Consent


1. **DISCUSS/CONSIDER RESOLUTION 20-05-01R** – Seth Sorensen, City Manager, presented the Council with Resolution 20-05-01R, a resolution approving change order #3 Meadowbrook Subdivision Project in the amount of \$211,322.43 with Edgardo Madrid and Associates. Mayor Flores stated that he felt it was a contractor error and should not be paid. Councilman Saldana stated that as a supervisor of the project that City Manager Sorensen should have caught the mistakes before six months passed by. Councilman Orona stated that this incident should teach all parties involved to communicate better with one another and document meetings.
