SUBJECT: LANDFILL DISPOSAL LIMITS

DATE: JUNE 6, 2019

Effective July 1, 2019, the Town of Pecos City will no longer accept any Type 1 - household waste from *commercial or industrial* sources at the City landfill. This will not impact the daily collection of trash from city dumpsters or citizen drop-off of waste.

Disposal of Type 4 - construction materials, will be limited to one (1) roll-off container per commercial account. The Pecos landfill will be closed for the day to Type 4 waste once it has reached the daily limit.

These limits are being imposed to ensure that the City remains within its landfill permit requirements, and are likely to continue indefinitely in order to be able to serve our primary customers – our citizens.

City residents will continue to be permitted to dispose of either Type 1 or Type 4 waste, subject to current rates, by showing a recent utility bill showing their address within the City.
