Extending COVID19 Disaster Declaration

**A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE COVID-19 DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED
BY MAYOR DAVID FLORES ON MARCH 19, 2020**

WHEREAS, The Town of Pecos City is a Home-Rule City duly organized according to the Laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19, commonly referred to as the *Coronavirus* has become a worldwide pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, Mayor David Flores issued a Disaster Declaration to address this pandemic in our community; and

WHEREAS, Said Declaration was designated for a period of seven days; and

WHEREAS, The City desires to extend this designation until such time as the effects of this pandemic may be reduced and the impact to our community is minimized.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PECOS CITY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the findings set out in the preamble to this resolution are hereby in all things approved and adopted.

Section 2. That the Declaration of March 19, 2020 is hereby extended until 11:59 PM on May 15, 2020, unless terminated or extended by the City Council before such time.

Section 3. That the City and its inhabitants and visitors shall adhere to all federal and state laws, edicts, proclamations, executive orders, etc., as well as the recommendations of the Center of Disease Controls (CDC) as they may pertain the addressing the COVID-19 pandemic.

Section 4. That the Mayor or their designee is hereby authorized to execute all documents related to these actions on behalf of the Town of Pecos City.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective from and after its passage.
