Dear Pecos Community Member:

At its April 9, 2015 meeting, the Town of Pecos City Council set aside \$45,000 in its current budget for the purchase of the second phase of playground equipment at Maxey Park. This act fulfills a commitment the City made to residents a few years ago. The City tore down Kid City after the playground reached its full life and fell into disrepair, and the City promised its residents that it would replace the playground in phases with an even better one. The City promised the improvements in phases due to its large budgetary obligations for Public Works projects. The \$45,000 commitment represents the second phase of the playground equipment.

In addition, at this April meeting, City Council urged City officials to pursue a public-private partnership. This partnership would allow the park to move along at a faster pace. Attached, please find renderings of the proposed playground and park area and costs associated with these improvements. We write in hopes that you would consider donating to this worthy cause. Maxey Park is beautiful, but with your help, we can make this an even greater attraction benefitting the wonderful residents and visitors of Pecos. The City will begin work on the second phase of the playground this summer. With your help, though, all improvements may be made this summer, with no delay until next budget year for the third phase of improvements. All donations will be recognized and will go toward improvements at Maxey Park.

Public-private partnerships are not new. Governmental entities around the country are pursuing public-private efforts because all community members—government officials, businesses, and private residents—realize the benefits of investing in their communities. The proposed partnership is an investment in our community. It creates a public space where all residents want to spend their time playing and socializing. It also creates a space where families can engage in other healthy, productive activities, like exercise. Most importantly, it instills pride in Pecos' residents and signals to visitors that Pecos is a great place to live, work, and play.
